Martin Dix Named New Energy Entrepreneur Of The Year

Current Cost managing director celebrates award win at Rosenblatt New Energy Awards

Aldershot, Hampshire March 2010: Current Cost founder Martin Dix was recognised as New Energy Entrepreneur of the Year 2010 at the third Rosenblatt New Energy Awards held at London's Natural History Museum on 25 February.

According to its organisers, the award "salutes a successful innovator in the renewable space, one that has advanced the cause of their business more effectively than their rivals." The judges considered a range of criteria before making their selection, taking into account pioneering products, sales and profits growth and the level of market penetration.
